Notes related to ABF BASIC Curriculum

Reading Levels 1&2, 3&4

Sites have the flexibility to juxtapose weeks so that books can be shared between two sites. Example: In Week 1 Site A would execute the reading curriculum Week 1, while Site B executes Week 2. Sites exchange books to begin week two.

Level 1&2 has several extra lessons for chapter books that can be used in five-to-six week programs.

Reading Levels 5&6

Sites have options to choose which books student will read.

A Strong Arm: The Story of Mamie "Peanut" Johnson, first female to pitch in the Negro Leagues approximately 2 weeks of curriculum with several lessons that were created for BASIC reading Level 3&4

The Journal of Biddy Owens 1948 Birmingham Black Barons Fictional biography with approximately two weeks of lessons.

We Are the Ship History of Negro Leagues Two weeks of curriculum. This book has been used for more than two weeks in previous BASIC programs.

Keeping Score Friendship of girl and soldier during Korean War set in Dodgers' Brooklyn NY four weeks of curriculum

Reading Levels 7&8

Bad Boy Autobiography of author Walter Dean Myers, who grew up in Harlem in 1930's Two weeks curriculum

Million Dollar Throw American football setting for young boy facing obstacles related to family and friends Four weeks curriculum
