



BASIC Teachers Summer 2022

BASIC is a program that redresses summer learning loss among at-risk children, ages 6 through 14. Its unique methodology, rotating the students from an academic station to a sports-skill station every fifty minutes for 6.5 hours per day, sets it apart, as it does not resemble normal school. Two programs will be held in Central Alabama-- one in Center Point and one in Pelham from June 2 through June 30.

Each program requires these academic positions, reading, math and intervention (related to reading and math). Teachers follow the BASIC curriculum in both disciplines. Class size varies from 10 to 17. (Instructors for sports are also required)

Responsibilities include:

- Implementing BASIC academic curriculum in which all lessons are sports related and/or sports curriculum as per BASIC daily lessons
- Creating a positive, supportive, and achievement-oriented environment for students.
- Motivating and holding students to high behavioral standards.
- Working as a team with all BASIC instructors to reinforce socio/emotional character traits

Qualifications:

- A bachelor's degree or above is desired and a teaching certificate
- Previous teaching experience
- Knowledge of innovative instructional practices and strategies.
- Excellent organizational and communication skills.
- Belief that all children can succeed.
- Ability to motivate students for each of the twenty-two days of the summer program
- Flexibility, a sense of humor, and a team player attitude.

Compensation: Pay related to work experience teaching. No benefits.
